PRIMARY FUNCTION

Responsible for performing a variety of routine cleaning of facility and general building maintenance tasks involving equipment and grounds.

RESPONSIBILITIES & DUTIES

- Clean and sanitize interior areas such as dance studios, conference room, hallways, restrooms, elevators, stairways, carpet/floors and other interior areas and pick-up debris on the grounds such as the parking lots, and exterior grounds as needed
- Performs set-up of facility for meetings, classes, workshops, etc. and for in-house events (includes physical moving of equipment, furniture, file cabinets, etc.)
- Monitors and maintains a variety of monthly, quarterly, and yearly inspection/logs such as extinguishers, emergency lighting, exit lighting, fire, generator, elevator, sprinkler, fire alarm, building evacuation, following standard procedure
- Basic building repairs including patching and painting walls, replacing ceiling tiles and other general maintenance and construction duties around the facility
- Perform minor electrical maintenance to include but not be limited to replacement or repair of fixtures (i.e., wall switches/outlets, light bulbs, minor appliances)
- Performs minor plumbing maintenance (i.e., unclogging of drains and faucets)
- Performing routine carpentry work (i.e., minor paint jobs, placing shelves)
- Assist with inventory control and building security
- First point of contact to respond to building and equipment alarms and other emergency situations
- Communicate with facility management about major damages and any work that requires outside professional assistance
- Assist in reconfiguration, install of offices and space (i.e., furniture, work surfaces, storage, file cabinets, etc.)
- Performs other work-related duties as assigned by Director of Facilities & Operations.
- Always maintain company safety procedures and comply with facility access control regulations
